Lough Foyle is home to a tantalising array of shellfish, the most celebrated of which is the Lough Foyle Irish Flat Oyster. Unique to our shores, it's prized by top restaurants for its taste and exclusivity. Only in season for a short period every year, you'll need to visit LegenDerry from October to December to sample this rare native oyster, which can be found as specials in some of our restaurants or sample 'Foyster' stout found in our local bars.

Once one of the largest whiskey distilling areas in the world, we are currently undergoing a renaissance in distilling with cutting edge craft breweries, products and experiences. Sample master brewer James Huey's creations at the Walled City Brewery a Northbound oak smoked beer, Rough Brothers or a fruity Redgate Cider.

You can tuck into much-loved local delicacies including pork sausages from Doherty's Meats (family owned since 1830), and deliciously sweet cream horn pastries (as seen on TV in Derry Girls). Enjoy our local produce such as Emily McCorkell's Lo & Slo barbecue sauces, award-winning Dart Mountain cheese or a selection of Monto's artisan chocolates.

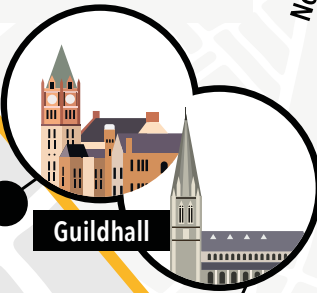
